Change an Orchestra Voice within a SET memory.

- 1 Turn on accordion and choose which set memory number you want to work with. Use the 2 small black buttons near your chin marked SET (minus) or + (plus) Write that SET number down for later recall.
- 2 Turn on ORCH tab (right hand controls)
- 3 Choose which one of the 14 register tab sounds you want to change. Make a note, write the register number down.
- 4 Hit > button (the one pointing to the floor). Screen shows current reg. number in small print and shows the Roland sound number in large print.
- 5 Use or + buttons to change sound. (Note these sounds will be the basic, unedited sounds from the accordion internal memory.)
- 6 When happy with new sound, SAVE to SET memory. PUSH and HOLD, Menu/Write button. See SYS in screen. (You do not want to save this change to the system memory.)
- 7 Push + button briefly. See SET in screen.
- 8 Push > button briefly. See Set number in screen. This should be the same number as you wrote down earlier.
- 9 Push > button 9 times until you see Write? Y N in screen
- 10 Push ENTER/YES button to permanently save this change.
