Install new sound in Set Memory Roland FR-8x:

Install a new (different) sound in Orch. 1 (or Orch. 2) SET memory

Begin by turning on accordion and selecting Orch 1 button, then:

- 1. turn on register button (1-14) you want to change
- 2 briefly push Menu/Write button
- 3 turn data knob until you see Orch. 1 Edit in screen (menu page 5)
- 4 push data knob
- 5 push data knob again see Tone highlight in yellow
- 6 turn data knob to the new Sound [tone] you want to install (play a few keys on the keyboard to be certain that is the sound you want to save.
- 7 push and HOLD Menu/write button until you see Write in screen.
- 8 You will see SYSTEM highlighted in yellow, turn data knob one click clockwise to see SET in screen
- 9 briefly push Menu/write button see Set 100 highlighted in yellow

(set 100 is Dale Mathis Turn-On set) You will see a different number if you had changed to a different set before you began this process.

- 10 briefly push Menu/write button see parameter values highlighted in yellow
- 11 briefly push Menu/write see clock face in screen (the system is saving to memory)
- 12 turn off accordion, then turn accordion on and check to see if the sound you selected has been saved to Register you selected.
