Two eighth notes receive the same amount of time as one quarter note, that is 1 beat.

This song is written in the Key of G, notice that the first and last chord in this song is G. The Key of G has one sharp in the Key Signature, F#. There are no F notes in this song, but if there were, you would play all F notes as F#, the black key.
